Be on the lookout for online renewals beginning in January 2010.

There will be a small service fee to renew online.

Once the site is up and running, a notice will be sent out.

Proposed Rule Change

The BOEALA will have a public hearing on 01/07/10 from 10:00am—11:00am to hear any comments on the following proposed rule.

135-X-7-.01 (4) (a) (b)

(a) Any person currently employed at an assisted living facility is authorized to apply for license renewal only if said facility that employs the licensee is licensed by the Alabama Department of Public Health.

(b) All applicants seeking a renewal license must submit the business license of the facility in which he/she is employed.

This rule is already in effect. The only change is that it was under one letter and now it will be under two.

Rule Change

Effective 10/8/2009, the BOEALA held a public hearing and voted on the following rule:

135-X-5-.07 (1)

An Applicant who has successfully passed the Section B exam has 30 days from the date of passing the exam to pay the initial licensing fee. Failure to do so will forfeit all previously paid fees and the applicant will be required to submit a new application and will be responsible for all applicable fees.
