





LICENSE RENEWAL

It is very important to keep up with the expiration date of your license and keep track of the continuing education hours you obtain throughout the year. The day and month of your expiration date will be the same every year.

When you receive your license renewal application in the mail the month prior to your expiration date, be sure you obtain all required continuing education hours by your expiration date and make sure your renewal application and fee is postmarked on or before the expiration date of your license.

BOEALA Rules Changes

The following rules were approved and will be effective November 3, 2008. Below is the rule number and a brief description of the rule.

135-x-2-.01 (p) – Added a definition for Residential Care Settings.

135-x-3-.01 – The Board will be required to meet quarterly each year and replaced Executive Secretary language with Executive Director.

135-x-4-.01 - Replacing Executive Secretary language with Executive Director.

135-x-5-.02 – GED's will be accepted if it is from a school approved and recognized by the education authorities of the state in which it is located.

135-x-5-.03 – Character reference forms must be completed from individuals employed in the health care or patient care industry.

135-X-5-.05 (4) – Cat. I licensees who wish to obtain their Cat. II license may do so after filling out another application and passing the Section A exam as long as they have taken the Section B exam within the last 12 months.

135-x-6-.01 (6) – Replacing Executive Secretary language with Executive Director.

135-x-7-.01 (4)(a) - Licensee's employed at unlicensed facilities will not be able to renew their ALA license.

135-X-8-01 (1) - Complaints do not have to be on forms provided by the BOEALA.

The following rules were approved and will be effective November 19, 2008. Below is the rule number and a brief description of the rule.

135-X-7-.02 (1, 4, 5)

- (l) changing the language to read: Is addicted to or dependent upon any drug, legal or illegal (prescription or street), that impairs such licensee's ability to function as an assisted living administrator
- (4) deleting language about consumer board members not being able to vote
- (5) deleted language about hearing committee

BOEALA Annual Survey Results for 2007-2008

Thanks to everyone who took the time to fill out the 2007-2008 Annual Licensee Survey that came in the mail with your license renewal. We got a lot of interesting comments and suggestions. At our last Board meeting on October 10, 2008, the BOEALA board reviewed the surveys and here are some answers to your suggestions.

- 1) Difficult to file a complaint with the current form.—<u>Effective November 3, you will no longer need a form to file a complaint.</u> All you will have to do is write a letter to the BOEALA.
- 2) If you have a Cat. I license and want to change to a Cat. II, you should not have to go through the entire training again.—Effective November 3, if you have completed the AIT training and passed the Section B exam within the previous 12 months, all you will have to do is take the Section A exam to obtain your Cat. II license.
- 3) Administrator licenses need to be renewed every 2 years.—<u>The Board's opinion is that the renewal cycle should remain as is; on an annual basis. Licensees are encouraged to obtain CEUs on a continuous basis thus allowing licensees to get the newest/updated training provided.</u>
- 4) Would like to see an offset for the number of CEUs needed based on experience.—The Board's opinion is that since the industry is continuously experience change, it is necessary for everyone to obtain the required number of CEUs based on licensure requirements.
- 5) Would like for the BOEALA to waive the 30 day time frame for CEU approval.—30 days are needed in order to process the CEU request as well as licensees need adequate time to check the BOEALA website for CEU approval.
- 6) Licensees should be allowed to get unlimited CEUs online.—The Board voted to keep the online CEUs as is; Cat. I may obtain 6 hours online, Cat. II may obtain 9 hours online.
